



## University of Michigan-Flint Admissions Checklist for Dual Enrollees

- Check with your high school's counseling office to determine your school district's policy regarding dual enrollment.
- Check if you are eligible for tuition reimbursement through your high school. You may choose to cover the cost of tuition on your own.
- Check the schedule of classes offered to see if it fits around your high school schedule
- Check your high school GPA
- Visit the University of Michigan-Flint campus (optional)
- Submit a completed [application](#)
- Mail in your \$30 non-refundable application fee
- Complete the [Grade Release Form](#), obtain the appropriate signatures and return to the Office of Admissions
- Complete the [Counselor Recommendation Form](#), obtain the appropriate signatures and return to the Office of Admissions
- Request that your high school transcripts be sent to the University of Michigan-Flint
- Submit all supporting documents with your application. This includes essays, resume, and letters of recommendation (optional)
- If you wish, you may request a waiver of the application fee for reasons of financial hardship (optional)
- If you plan to continue as a dual enrolled student, you will need to fill out an application and grade release form for each semester you would like to attend
