Computer Science 121 Exam

CSC 121: course waived

You have chosen to waive Computer Science 121.

CSC 121: taking grade/credit

You have chosen to have the grade included in your GPA. **You must** enroll in CSC 121, Section 99 and pay for the course. Your grade will be awarded at the end of the term.

Score 85-100	You can take the credit and grade of “A” - OR - You can waive the course
Score 75-84	You can take the credit and grade of “B”
Score 65-74	You can take the credit and grade of “C”
Score 60-64	You can take the credit and grade of “D”
Score 0-59	You can not take the credit or grade

Math Exam

Take Beg Algebra at Comm Coll

You have placed into beginning algebra. The beginning algebra course is not offered at the University of Michigan-Flint. You may take the course as a guest student at your local community college.

Math Placement into 090

You have placed into Intermediate Algebra. The credit for Math 090 does not count in the total credits needed for graduation.

Math Placement into 111

You have placed into College Algebra.

Math Placement into 118

You have placed into Calculus for business management.

Math Placement into 120

You have placed into Pre-Calculus.

Math Placement into 121

You have placed into Calculus I.

Must take Blue Math Exam

Your score on the Yellow Math Exam indicates that you need to complete the Blue Math Exam for your placement.

Must take Yellow Math Exam

Your score on the Blue Math Exam indicates that you need to complete the Yellow Math Exam for your placement.

Reading Exam

ACT reading requires ENG 100*

Based upon your ACT score for reading, you are required to take ENG 100.

ACT reading waives ENG 100

Based upon your ACT score for reading, you are not required to take ENG 100.

Reading: ENG 100 not required

Based upon your score on the Reading Placement Exam, you are not required to take ENG 100.

Reading Plcmt into ENG 100

Based upon your score on the Reading Placement Exam, you are required to take ENG 100.

SAT reading requires ENG 100*

Based upon your SAT score for reading, you are required to take ENG 100.

SAT reading waives ENG 100

Based upon your SAT score for reading, you are not required to take ENG 100.

**If your ACT or SAT scores have required you to take ENG 100, you may still be eligible to waive the course by taking the Reading exam. Contact the Academic Advising and Career Center at (810) 762-3085.*

Writing Exam*

WRT Plcmt: ENG 109 (1 credit)

You placed into one (1) credit of ENG 109 which requires logging twenty-eight (28) hours in the Writing Center during the semester in addition to being enrolled in ENG 111 (or ENG 112 for those students that already have credit for ENG 111).

WRT Plcmt: ENG 109 (3 credits)

You placed into three (3) credits of ENG 109 which requires logging eighty-four (84) hours during the semester. Fifty-six (56) hours will be completed in the Writing Center and twenty-eight (28) hours will be completed in class.

WRT Plcmt: ENG 111

You have been placed into ENG 111. Your writing skills are sufficient for enrollment in ENG 111.

WRT Plcmt: ENG 112

You have been placed into ENG 112. Your writing skills are sufficient for enrollment in ENG 112 or you have transferred AP credits or credits for ENG 111 from another institution.

**Writing Placement Exam performance will not exempt students from ENG 111 or ENG 112 but rather will determine if additional help through ENG 109 is needed during or before completing the ENG 111 and ENG 112 sequence.*
