

Applications to the Teacher Certificate Program for **Fall 2008** will be available online, www.umflint.edu/departments/edu , starting January 1, 2008.

You will need to print the application, complete it and submit it to the Education Department office. Please take a moment to review the application procedure and timelines.

- **Applications available January 1-15, 2008**
- **Application deadline is January 15, 2008 at 5:00 pm**
- **February 5, 2008 all transfer transcripts due (See Registrar's office for request form to send transcripts to the EDU office)**
- **January 21-February 29, 2008 application review**
- **First full week in March admission decisions mailed to applicants**
- **Students who wish to reapply for admission need to stop by the EDU office to see the admissions evaluator and complete a new misdemeanor/felony form**
- **Incomplete applications cannot be processed**
- **Students wishing to petition admission decision to the Student Review panel should plan to do so immediately after decisions are mailed. Student Review Panel petition forms can be found in the Education Office or online, www.umflint.edu/departments/edu.**

Minimum admission criteria are listed below:

- **Academic Achievement - An established 2.75 overall grade point average as well as a 2.75 grade point average in the desired teachable major/minor subject area(s). Transfer students are reminded that gpa's will be computed using ALL courses that are potentially transferable to UM-F including courses graded below "C".**
- **Michigan Basic Skills Test - A passing score of 220 in each of the three test areas, reading, writing, and mathematics. Students taking the test on January 19, 2008 may still apply in January. Test results are expected to arrive February 15, 2008 in time for admission decisions. Make sure your test results are sent to UM-Flint.**
- **Prerequisite Courses Completed - PSY 100 with grade of "C" or better. Elementary applicants must also have in addition to the above course EDM 121 or MTH/EDU 115 with a "C" or better and completion of SCI 125 or 126 with a passing grade. These courses CANNOT be in progress at the time of application.**
- **Minimum Credit Completion - Applicants must have completed at the time of application 18 credits in the teachable major and 12 credits in the teachable minor(s) and meet gpa requirements. 9 credits also need to be completed for those pursuing an Early Childhood endorsement. Courses in progress WILL NOT be considered.**
