EDUCATION PROGRAM ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- 1) Completion of at least 55 semester hours of coursework.
- 2) An overall GPA of 2.75 or better. GPA will be computed by using ALL courses that potentially are transferable to UM-Flint, including courses for which the student has received a grade below “C.”
- 3) A 2.75 GPA in each major or minor teaching area.
- 4) Successful completion of the Basic Skills Test portion of the Michigan Test for Teacher Certification.
- 5) Completion of SCI 125 or 126 with a passing grade; PSY 100, PSY 237, MTH 115: all with grades of “C” or better.
- 6) Completion of 18 credit hours in each teaching major and 12 credit hours in each teaching minor.

Grade Point Requirements To be eligible for student teaching and to be recommended for teacher certification, students must have a grade of “C” or better in all courses listed under the required education category, an overall GPA of at least 2.75, and at least a 2.75 average in all education courses, minor subject area courses, as well as Early Childhood courses taken at the University of Michigan-Flint and other institution
