- *Minimum 55 credits completed, 18 credits completed in teaching major; 12 in teaching minor; overall and major/minor GPA's of 2.750 or higher.*

Education admission requirements for secondary concentrators are:

- *PSY 100-minimum of "C"*
- *Completion and passing of the MTTC Basic Skills Exam*
- *Minimum 55 credits completed, 18 credits completed in teaching major; 12 in teaching minor; overall and major/minor GPA's of 2.750 or higher.*
