Requirements. Thirty-six credits, as follows:

- A. Literature. Fifteen credits as follows:
- 1. ENG 204 or 205 or 206 or 207
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 - 2. A course in American or American ethnic literature from: ENG 213, 215, 353, 355, 356, 357, 364, 368, 374, 382, 432, 433.
 - 3. Two courses at the 300 level or above in British literature before 1800.

- B. Writing. Eighteen credits distributed as follows:
- 1. Composition Theory. ENG 336, 340. (6 credits).
 - 2. Written Communication. Three from ENG 252, 260, 296, 298, 309, 345, 354, 363, 391, 392, 393, 399; ENG/COM 338, ENG/EDU 412. (9 credits).
 - 3. Linguistics. One from ENG/LIN 200, 244 (244 recommended). (3 credits).
- C. Senior Seminar. ENG 400. (3 credits).
- D. Completion of an Individual **Major Portfolio**.

Please note:

- No more than 40 hrs in English may be counted toward the total hours required to graduate (excluding 100 level English classes).
- Cross-listed courses taken through the alternate department do not count in the 40 hour rule
- 33 of the 120 credit hours must be at 300 level or above.
