<b>Steps to Follow</b>	<p>Click on the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Go to the indicated webpage</li> <li>Login</li> <li>Financial Aid</li> <li>Awards</li> <li>Award by Aid Year</li> <li>Select Aid Year</li> <li>Review Award Overview [Tab]</li> <li>Accept Award Offer [Tab]</li> <li>Read <a href="#">"Required Reading"</a></li> <li>Return to SIS</li> <li>Scroll down and follow the instructions on the web site to accept/decline/decide later</li> </ol>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Go to the indicated webpage.</li> <li>Click on Complete New MPN for student loans.</li> <li>Be sure to select the <b>University of Michigan-Flint</b> as your school.</li> <li>It should take 20-30 minutes to complete.</li> <li>Students will immediately receive a confirmation number so that you know the federal government has received and accepted the EMPN.</li> <li>Office of Financial Aid receives electronic confirmation that the EMPN has been completed.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Click on Entrance &amp; Exit Counseling (upper right corner of site).</li> <li>Click on Tutorial and Quiz (new session) for Stafford Loan</li> <li>You will receive a confirmation of passing the quiz - print for your records.</li> <li>It should take 15-20 minutes to complete.</li> <li><b>Select option "I don't have a pin!" and enter the requested data.</b></li> <li>Type <u>University of Michigan</u> and select University of Michigan – Flint.</li> <li>Your quiz results will be transmitted electronically to the Office of Financial Aid.</li> </ul>
<b>Additional Information</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Work study is canceled if not accepted by September 30<sup>th</sup>.</li> <li>Loans will be canceled if not accepted by the end of the loan period.</li> <li>Students who have a student loan debt greater than \$40,000 will be required to attend a loan counseling session with a Financial Aid Officer in order to receive Federal Direct Loans. Students will be notified of this on the requirements screen (eligibility section) in SIS.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A Direct Loan Electronic Master Promissory Note (EMPN) must be completed in order to receive Direct Loan funds.</li> <li>The EMPN authorizes the University of Michigan-Flint to credit Direct Loan funds to your student account.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Students borrowing through the Federal Direct Loan Program must complete counseling in order to receive their Direct Loan funds.</li> </ul>

**PERKINS BORROWERS**

- If you accept a Perkins Loan, you will be mailed instructions with a Master Promissory Note (MPN). Perkins MPNS are signed one time and are valid throughout your continued attendance at UMF, (continuing UMF students who have already signed a MPN will not be sent a new one). Students are required to fill out a new Perkins Loan Questionnaire each academic year.
