Kay Sampson Kelly established this scholarship in 2007 to recognize a promising, non-traditional theatre student. Ms. Kelly graduated from the University of Michigan-Flint in 1981 with a BA in Theatre. She is indebted to benefactors who provided to her merit-based scholarships to see her through her education and was determined to return the favor one day. Ms. Kelly started her education, at an older age, in the Winter term of 1978 and, through dedicated work, was able to graduate with those who had started in the Fall term before her. She appeared in every production during her time at UM-Flint, with the exception of the last one on which she served as Stage Manager. Ms. Kelly went on to work as a professional actor in New York. When she returned to Flint, she committed herself to helping to revitalize the city and became a champion and leader of Flint Shakespeare in the Park at Kearsley Park.

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1. Applicants must be full-time students, at least 25 years of age, enrolled in the Theatre program who demonstrate a commitment to the theatrical productions of the university.
 2. Applicants must have attained a minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA, or, for entering freshmen, a high school GPA of 3.25 is required.
 3. The scholarship is only available for the Winter term.
