PROCEDURES FOR SPECIFIC REQUESTS

1. Petitions concerning a course:

When adding a course for a past term, a drop/add form (signed by the course instructor and the graduate chair) and supplemental grade report (signed by the instructor and stamped by the department) must be attached. When dropping a course for a past term, a drop/add form (signed by the course instructor and the graduate chair) must be attached. If petitioning to expunge a course from a past term, a drop/add form (signed by the course instructor and the graduate chair) and a letter from the instructor, on department letterhead, stating that the course was not attended past the third week of classes must be attached. If petitioning to expunge an entire term from your past registration, a withdrawal form (signed by the graduate chair) and a letter from the instructor stating that the course was not attended past the third week of classes must be attached.

2. Request for extension of time to degree:

A new deadline (month/year) should be specified along with an explanation of why the extension is needed. An additional memo from the department chair supporting this request and stating that the degree will still be "state-of-the-art" may also be required.

3. Request for graduate credit for an undergraduate course:

This petition must include information about what additional work the student will do to be considered for graduate credit.
