THE CARL AND SARAH MORGAN GRADUATE STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

The Carl and Sarah Morgan Graduate Student Scholarship was established in 1996 with a gift from the Morgan Trust to the University of Michigan-Flint. This gift is designated to provide financial assistance for University of Michigan-Flint graduate students.

Scholarship Guidelines:

1. Applicants must be admitted to a UM-Flint graduate program and have completed all prerequisite courses. Applicants must have earned a minimum cumulative 3.3 GPA based on a 4.0 scale as an undergraduate, or have minimum cumulative B+ average as a University of Michigan-Flint graduate student.
2. Applicants must submit a personal essay, 250 words or more, expressing their interest in and reasons for seeking scholarship selection.
3. Applicants must submit one letter of reference from a faculty member familiar with the student's academic work.
4. Scholarship awards will be applied directly to the student's tuition and fees accounts at the University.
5. The scholarship selection committee is comprised of the Dean of Graduate Programs and Research, a minimum of three Graduate Program Directors, and a representative from the Office of Financial Aid.
6. The Dean of Graduate Programs and Research will provide the Office of Development, by August 1 of each academic year, with a detailed report which includes scholarship recipient information and individual scholarship award distribution.

Scholarship Application Requirements:

Applicants must submit the following materials to be considered for this scholarship:

- University of Michigan-Flint Scholarship Application
- Personal essay (see #2 above)
- One (1) faculty letter of reference (see #3 above)
- Transcripts
