FOR ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

This scholarship will recognize academic excellence of students enrolled in a University of Michigan-Flint graduate program.

Scholarship Guidelines:

1. Applicants must be admitted to a graduate program and have completed all prerequisite courses and earned a minimum of twelve hours of graduate credit at the University of Michigan-Flint.
2. Applicants must submit a personal statement of one page or less as to why they qualify for the award.
3. Applicants must submit two letters of reference from faculty familiar with their academic work. At least one of the letters must be from a faculty member in a University of Michigan graduate program.
4. Selection will be based on academic performance. Priority will be given to students in those programs, which have fewest sources of student financial assistance available.
5. The scholarship selection committee is comprised of the Dean of Graduate Programs and Research, a minimum of three Graduate Program Directors, and a representative from the Office of Financial Aid.
6. The award is not renewable.

Scholarship Application Requirements:

Applicants must submit the following materials to be considered for this scholarship:

- UM-Flint scholarship Application
- Personal Statement (see #2 above)
- Two (2) letters of reference (see #3 above)
- Transcripts
