

You can pull citation or identifier information off any open web site using *Grab-It*.

Grab-It looks for displayed information and allows you to store same into RefWorks.

Grab-It looks for:

- Titles
- ISBNs
- DOIs
- Or just web URL addresses

To use *Grab-It*, you must download the feature into your browser.

- Some browsers allow you to simply drag-and-drop the feature into their toolbar.
- Others (such as Explorer 7) require you to save *Grab-It* into your “favorites” list.

To use:

- Open the web site you’re interested in viewing.
- Click *Grab-It* from the browser toolbar - **OR** -
- Open your browser “favorites” and select *Grab-It* from your list.

Grab-It pulls what it determines to be pertinent information off the web site and holds it for you to examine. If more information is found, it will be displayed under a more-information tab.

If you are satisfied with the information retrieved, use the “import” button to move the items from *Grab-It* into your RefWorks account.

Note: You MUST open your RefWorks account to transfer items from *Grab-It* to RefWorks!

Find *Grab-It* under the “Tools” (drop-down) box in RefWorks along with written instructions for installing *Grab-It* into either pc or mac computers.
