## **Satellite Scholarship Application The University of Michigan-Flint**

### **Purpose:**

The Satellite Scholarship program awards jump-start funds to students who are entering UM-Flint programs offered at the satellite campuses of Lansing Community College (LCC), St. Clair County Community College (SC4) and Wayne County Community College District (WCCCD). Scholarships are awarded for the first semester only. Students must be enrolled in one of the currently offered classes/programs held at a satellite campus.

### **Scholarship Guidelines for individuals returning Summer 2008 or later.**

1. Applicants must be enrolled in at least three credit hours for the semester they are requesting consideration.
2. Scholarship awards are limited to no more than \$500 per student. Students will receive \$100 per credit hour up to \$500.
3. Applicant must be enrolled in one of the currently offered courses/programs at the satellite campus.
4. Scholarships are applied directly to the student's account and can be used for tuition, fees and books.
5. Scholarships will be made available to students following the drop/add period (approximately two weeks after the start of the semester).
6. Scholarships are not based on financial need.
7. Scholarships are not renewable.
8. If a recipient drops the course for which he/she has received the scholarship, he/she will not be eligible for future funds.
9. Scholarship recipients are eligible the first semester only.
10. The scholarship selection committee will be comprised of two individuals from the Office of Extended Learning.
11. Scholarships will be cancelled for recipients who fail to be enrolled for at least three credits by the end of the drop/add period for the semester(s) in which they are receiving scholarship funding.
12. Students who take the first semester courses online are NOT eligible for the scholarship.

### **Scholarship Application Requirements:**

Applications are available from the Office of Extended Learning, 241 David M. French Hall or the Office of Financial Aid, 277 University Pavilion. **They must be received by the Office of Financial Aid before the first day of the semester for which the scholarship is being requested.**
