## **Introduction**

2009-2010 has been a year of positive growth in all areas for the Office of Research – research administration, research compliance, undergraduate research and project support. A solid core of training programs and workshops has been established to serve faculty, students and staff at all stages of their research and scholarly activities. A new Director of Research was recruited and hired, and staff members covered the needs of the Office during transitional months of this year.

## **Office of Research Mission Statement**

The Office of Research at the University of Michigan-Flint strives to provide central research support services for faculty, students and staff. Our objective is to foster a culture of research and project support for investigators throughout the entire "lifecycle" of their research initiatives in the following areas:

- Research and Sponsored Programs Administration
- Research Compliance (Coordinated with the Institutional Review Board)
- Undergraduate Research
- Project Management & Fiscal Support

## **Status of 2009-2010 Goals**

- Offer an integrated series of workshops/events that support faculty research (Grant writing and budgeting and information searching; Fulbright Scholars program; SPSS/NVivo, Community of Science, IRB (Human Subjects) – *Completed, full listing at: <http://www.umflint.edu/research/>*
- Use the databases we have developed to better monitor and support faculty research efforts – especially with efforts involving coordination with Corporate and Foundation Relations – *Completed.*
- Develop/revise/implement the following items:
  - New goal by new Director: Webinar grant workshops by federal agencies for faculty – *Completed, this was the first time that UM-Flint has offered the Webinars from Washington, D.C.*
  - RCAC funding for non-tenure track faculty – *Completed.*
  - Implement the new ePAF and eResearch systems – *Completed.*
  - F&A costs waiver for grants proposals under \$10,000 – *Completed.*
  - Faculty research news publication – *Fall 09 (Summer 2010 issue pending).*
  - Meeting of Minds research conference for undergraduate students hosted by UM-Flint – *Completed, 235 students signed up to attend or give presentations and posters from three universities, UM-Flint, UM-Dearborn, and Oakland University.*
- Increase the available funding for the UROP program – *Completed, funding at \$20,000+.*
- Increase total number of proposals submitted for internal and external funding across all units – *Completed.*
- Increase the amount of funding received through external grant applications and F&A cost return – *Completed.*
  - *One award received from the Federal Government for Financial Aid for \$627,200 in special funding, which is not expected to be renewed in federal legislation.*

- *We have significantly increased the number of applications and funding requested through federal programs. Review of federal applications often takes much longer than non-federal applications and many applications are still pending.*

**Goals for 2010-2011**

- Increase the competitiveness and quality of proposals.
- Complete the reaccreditation process for IRB
- Complete the approval process for the Animal Care site for new research projects
- Develop and host a Student Research Conference at UM-Flint for graduate and undergraduate students by coordinating an event with the Office of Associate Provost and Dean of Graduate Programs (and make progress toward a Faculty Research Conference).
- Continue to provide administrative support for Start-up Research Funds of new faculty; Mentoring Program of new faculty; Internal Grants for faculty and staff; Workshops and statistical consulting for faculty and students; Undergraduate Research Opportunity Program; and other research-related programs for students and faculty

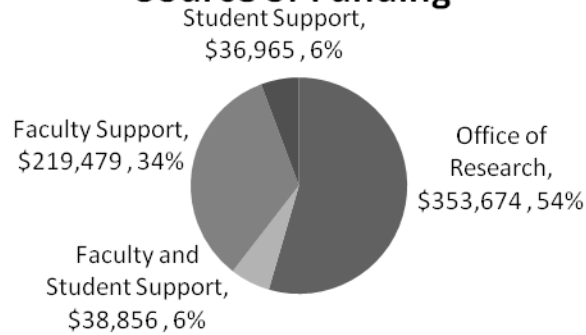

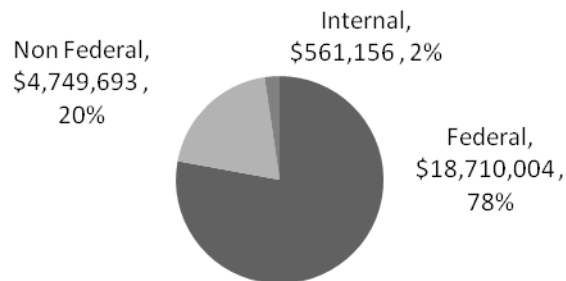

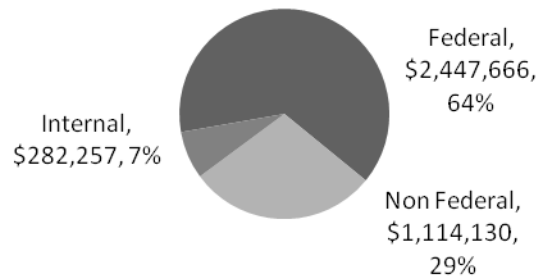
### Source of Funding
