Clarice Jean Averill graduated with honors from the University of Michigan - Flint with a Bachelors Degree in Social Work, winning the prestigious Maize and Blue Award for distinguished scholarship. An avid sports booster and tireless volunteer, Jean coached softball at the little league, junior high and senior high levels. She continued to support the Montrose Athletic Booster Club long after her own children had graduated. Her enthusiasm, laughter and zest for living were contagious. Jean dedicated her life to working with children, from operating a day care center in her home to her interest in supporting distressed children. Her life exemplified the profession she practiced so well. A woman of great faith, Jean was a member of the Amity Sisters of Montrose United Methodist Church, providing care-giving charity work and mutual support to those in need. Her husband, family and friends contributed to this memorial scholarship.

4. The scholarship recipient must have a minimum of a 3.0 grade point average.
