

## Catherine Maxine Duesberry Scholarship

Catherine Maxine Duesberry was born in Grand Rapids, Michigan on February 21, 1971 to Sadie and Floris Moran. She was known as Maxine to friends and family. The family moved to Pinckney, Michigan, and after her father's death, to Flint, where Maxine attended Flint Central High School. She went on to Michigan State Normal College (now Eastern Michigan University) in Ypsilanti, graduating with a Bachelor's degree in Education in 1939.

Maxine Duesberry began her teaching career at Garfield Elementary School in Flint where she taught from 1939 to 1943. From 1943 to 1964 she taught at Martin Elementary; and at Pierson Elementary from 1964 to the time of her retirement in 1980. Maxine and her sister were both teachers, no doubt having been influenced by her aunt, Fannie Bradley, who taught many years and retired at Principal of Pierce Elementary School. According to Ms. Duesberry's dear friend, Glen Auten, Maxine was a gentle, kind woman, a caring and dedicated teacher, and a most conscientious member of the Flint School District.

The Caroline Maxine Duesberry Scholarship was established in 1995 at the University of Michigan-Flint in her memory. The fund provides financial assistance for students enrolled in the Teacher Education Program at the University.

### Scholarship Guidelines:

1. Applicants must be currently enrolled as full-time students at the University of Michigan-Flint.
2. Applicants must have applied and been accepted to the Teacher Education Program, and provide proof of acceptance.
3. Applicants must have a minimum 3.00 grade point average.
4. This award is to be used for tuition, books and fees, and will be credited to the recipient's University account. Scholarship monies not used must be returned to the Caroline Maxine Duesberry Scholarship Fund.
5. Scholarship awards may be renewable.
6. If the scholarship is not awarded during an academic year, funds will remain in the expendable restricted scholarship account.
