

THE KATHRYN CARL EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP

The Kathryn Carl Education Scholarship was established with a gift from Kathryn Carl to the University of Michigan - Flint. Mrs. Carl, who died in 1991 at the age of 93, was a graduate of the University of Michigan - Flint and spent 35 years as a teacher in the Flint Public Schools. This endowment will provide assistance to University of Michigan - Flint students majoring in Education.

Scholarship Guidelines:

1. Scholarship recipients must be residents of Flint or have graduated from a high school in Genesee County.
2. Scholarship recipients must have been admitted to a University of Michigan - Flint education program.
3. Scholarship recipients must be currently enrolled in the University of Michigan - Flint with a 3.0 cumulative grade point average.
4. Financial need will be taken into consideration in awarding this scholarship.
5. The selection of scholarship recipients will be made by the Education Department faculty.
6. The amount of the scholarship will be credited to the recipient's University tuition account.
7. Scholarships are renewable; however, the student must reapply.
