

SOCIAL WORK LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP

The Social Work Leadership Scholarship was established in 1999 by University of Michigan - Flint Social Work alumni and faculty. The scholarship is designated toward the support and recognition of outstanding University of Michigan - Flint Social Work students who have demonstrated a commitment to academic achievement and leadership potential.

Scholarship Guidelines:

1. Applicants must have been admitted to the Social Work Program, and have successfully completed 55 credit hours.
2. Applicants must have a minimum 3.0 grade point average.
3. Applicants must include a cover letter, addressed to the scholarship selection committee, in which they address their academic accomplishments, community service activities and career goals.
4. The scholarship selection committee will be comprised of 3 members of the Social Work faculty.
