- (1) If you have eight semester credit hours of anatomy and physiology from a four year school, you will have completed both BIO 2870 and BIO 3200 for the physical therapy program.
- (2) The physical therapy program only requires two semesters of chemistry. You do not need the equivalent of Wayne State's CHM 1220/1230 and CHM 1240/1250.
- (3) For the pharmacy program starting with the class that enters fall 2016, you must have at least six semester credit hours of anatomy and physiology with at least three semester credit hours of anatomy of physiology at the 3000-level or higher

- (3) For the Physical Therapy program, you need to take two 3000-level or higher courses in the same discipline. For example, two 3000-level or higher courses in biology or two 3000-level or higher courses in psychology.
- (4) For the Radiation Therapy Technology program, you can take either PSY 2300, PSY 2400 or PSY 2410.
