#### Scholarship Guidelines:

1. If intercollegiate athletics become sanctioned at the University of Michigan-Flint, first preference will be given to an intercollegiate student athlete. Until then, first preference will be given to a UM-Flint club sports athlete.
2. Applicants may be full-time or part-time students.
3. Applicants must be pursuing an undergraduate degree program.
4. Applicants must demonstrate financial need.
5. Applicants must have a 2.5 grade point average, or high school equivalent grade point average, at the time of application.
6. Selection will be based on a demonstrated commitment to academic achievement, well rounded high school experiences, and university or civic activities.
