- Genesee County Armed Services Veterans Scholarship Fund: For veterans or children whose parent died as a result of military service and who graduated from a Genesee County high school.
- Jones, Beverly G. Scholarship for Veterans' Bachelor of Science in Nursing Students: For veterans enrolled in the Accelerated VBSN program.
- Student Veterans Scholarship: A general UM-Flint scholarship offered to veterans.

VETERANS' BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN NURSING (VBSN)

The VBSN is open to all honorably or generally discharged service members with military healthcare training. It is a compressed program building on veterans' prior military healthcare training for those seeking a Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) degree. Veterans will complete the program well prepared to pass the Registered Nurse (RN) licensure exam and gain successful employment.
