Students must satisfy degree requirements in effect at the time of their admission to the University of Michigan-Flint. To be recommended for the bachelor's degree, a student must have registered as a degree candidate at the University of Michigan-Flint for the last 30 credits. A transfer student must earn a minimum of 45 credit hours at the University of Michigan-Flint, including the last 30 credits.
