

SAT REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR UM-FLINT TEACHER CANDIDATES

Below are step-by-step instructions for registering for the SAT. Please read through each step before moving on to the next.

Step 1: Sign Up for an Account

Important to note:

- Click [HERE](#) to start the process and click “Register” under the test date you intend to register for.
- If you already have an account with College Board, then use your sign in information to access your profile.
- If you do not already have an account, then click “sign up” and follow the steps.

Step 2: Create your Student Account

Important to note:

- Under the field “Where do you go to school?” type *University of Michigan-Flint*. This seems obvious but the searchable options only reveal high schools.
- Double-check your information for accuracy!
- After you continue, it may ask you to confirm your information.

Step 3: SAT Registration

Important to note:

- In the “Update Personal Info” section, please search for and select the high school you graduated from.
 - Under “Your Expected Graduate Date”, leave the Month and Year fields alone.
 - Under “Current Grade Level”, select “No longer in high school”.
- Double-check your information for accuracy before continuing.

Step 4: Create Student Profile

Important to note:

- Complete the sections regarding your high school GPA and academic information.
- Double-check your information for accuracy!

Step 5: Select Test Center and Date

Important to note:

- Test Type: Select “SAT”, not SAT Subject Tests.
- You are not required to take the SAT Essay.
- Select your Test Center that is most convenient for you.
- Double-check your information for accuracy!

Step 6: Upload Photo

Important to note:

- Follow the directions for uploading a photo ID.
- The College Board requirements for photo IDs are quite strict so double-check that your photo is satisfactory.

Step 7: Payment

Important to note:

- Have your form of payment ready.
- Double-check your information for accuracy!
- Check out and print out your admission ticket. You will need this ticket for admission on test day.

Step 8: Keep Checking your Email!

- The College Board may send you a verification email at any point between the time you register for a test and the date of the test. As an adult test taker (non-high schooler), you may be required to verify your identity and intent to take the test. Please regularly check your email associated with your College Board account (including junk or spam folders) so you do not miss it.
