



Summer Literacy Camp

Quick Facts about the Camp

- **For children entering 3rd through 12th grade**
- **Fully online** tutoring, requiring Internet access and a tablet/computer
- **Daily tutoring from July 8th through July 31st** (Starts on a Wednesday for partial week, continues for three weeks Monday-Friday)
- **Approximately 1 to 1.5 hours each weekday** (Tutor and families will establish daily times; collaborative online activities will be scheduled with other campers).
- **Tuition is \$95***- payable online. (*Limited scholarships are available based on demonstrated financial need.)
- **Your child's participation is expected in all 18 sessions across the four weeks.**

FAQS

1. Do I need to be present with my child to participate?

No. Our candidates are experienced with children of all ages (most are practicing teachers) and we would like them to have a realistic experience in remote tutoring with your child. Just make sure your child is in a quiet space without interruptions for tutoring each day. You or another adult may need to help them log on but that's it!

2. What is required at home to help my child participate?

Your child will need a tablet or computer with Internet access. This should have audio and video capability so the tutor and child can see one another. Headphones for your child are recommended. Your child will also get fun literacy activities to complete outside Camp time (at the tutor's discretion).

We use a secure videoconferencing platform, Bluejeans, for the tutoring sessions. Sessions will be audio-recorded for the course instructor to support and coach all tutors.

3. When should I apply to Camp for my child?
