## Quick Facts – Fall 2017

### General Student Body

- 7,836 Total Students
- 6,434 Undergraduate students
- 1,402 Graduate students
- 91.6% of all students are Michigan Residents
- 50.1% live in Genesee County (3923 students)
- 348 (4.44%) International students (NRA)
- Greatest number of International students come from; Saudi Arabia (124; 35.63%), India (77; 22.13%), and China (35; 10.06%)
- 59.20% of undergraduates are full time(12 credits)
- 63.55% of graduate students are part time (6 credits)
- 61.46% of all students are female
- 19.93% of all students are minorities and 3.01% are two or more races
- 32.90% of all undergraduates are “non-traditional” ( $\geq 25$ )
- 57.6% of the undergraduates are upper classmen and account for 56.13% of fall 2017 undergraduate credits
- In 2016-17, there were 181,626 credits taken by students
- 80.14% of our Alumni live in Michigan
- Since 1956, UM-Flint has conferred 37,914 undergraduate and 7,355 graduate degrees
- 2016-17 Fiscal Year Equated Students (FYES) was 6,544
- Faculty to Student FTE Ratio 1 to 13
- Staff to Student FTE Ratio 1 to 10

### Transfers

- 10.83% of the undergraduates (697) are New Transfer students
- Top 5 feeders: Mott 32.14%, Baker College 5.31%, Oakland Community College 4.88%, Lansing Community College 4.73%, and Oakland University 3.59%

### Freshman Class

- 10.69% (688) of the undergraduates are new freshman
- 95.34% of the new freshmen are full time
- 62.13% of the new freshmen are female
- 23.25% of the new freshmen are from minority groups and 4.50% are two or more races
- 2.18% are International students
- Average High School GPA was 3.40
- Average SAT Composite Score was 1078
- Top Feeder High Schools : Grand Blanc High School 9.16%, Swartz Creek High School 5.23%, Carman-Ainsworth High School 5.09%, Davison High School 5.09%, Flushing Senior High School 3.92%, Fenton High School 3.63%, Linden High School 3.49%, Lapeer High School 3.34%, and Kearsley High School 3.20%

### Retention & Graduation

- First Year Retention Rate for Full Time First Time Freshman was 77.36% for the 2016 cohort; up 8.99 points from the fall 2015 cohort retention rate
- Four Year Graduation rate was 14.46% for 2011 cohort

- Six Year Graduation rate was 43.85% for 2011 cohort
- Eight Year Graduation rate was 40.07% for 2008 cohort

### Undergraduate Majors

There are over 100 possible majors/concentrations/specializations that apply to 12 Bachelor Degrees.

- 18.58% undergraduates are Nursing or pre-nursing majors
- 19.52% STEM (Science, Engineering, Technology and Math)
- 14.54% of undergraduates are Business majors
- 4.59% are Education Related majors of which 8.5% are pursuing teaching in Science & Math
- 7.63% of undergraduates are non-teaching Biology or Biochemistry majors
- 4.28% of undergraduates are Computer Science or Information Systems majors
- 14.92% of undergraduates have not declared a major

### Undergraduate Degrees

- In 2016-17 UM-Flint conferred 1,223 undergraduate degrees.
- 18.00% of all UG degrees issued in Business
- 23.63% of all UG degrees issued in Nursing
- 15.62% of all UG degrees issued in STEM programs
- 4.00% of all UG degrees issued in Elementary Education and Teaching

### Graduate Majors

23 different Masters Degrees, 1 Post Bachelor's Certificate, 1 Post Master's Degree, 8 Post Master's Certificate, 3 Professional Doctoral, 2 Ph.D's, and 4 Post Doctorate Certificates

- 15.98% of graduate students are in Education
- 15.69% of graduate students are in Physical Therapy
- 13.55% of graduate students are in Business
- 21.89% of graduate students are in Nursing
- 7.20% of graduate students are in Public Administration

### Graduate Degrees

- In 2016-17 UM-F conferred 562 graduate degrees
- 16.37% issued in Education
- 15.48% issued in Business
- 9.78% issued in Public Administration
- 16.37% issued were in Physical Therapy

### Faculty & Staff

- Total regular is 1,200 = 837 FT & 363 PT
- Total Staff is 627 = 511 FT & 32 PT & 84 GSRA
- Total Faculty is 573 = 326 FT & 247 PT
- 39.3% of Full-Time Faculty - Tenured
- 25.4% Full Time-Faculty - Tenure Track
- 35.3% Full Time-Faculty - Not on Tenure system
- 22.1% Full Time-Faculty - minority groups
- 19.2% Full Time-Staff - minority groups
