

University of Michigan-Flint Quick Facts – Fall 2018

General Student Body

- 7,532 Total Students
- 6,097 Undergraduate students
- 1,435 Graduate students
- 92.6% of all students are Michigan Residents
- 52.9% live in Genesee County
- 309 (4.1%) International students (NRA)
- Greatest number of International students come from; Saudi Arabia (88; 28.5%), India (78; 25.2%), and China (26; 8.4%)
- 60.3% of undergraduates are full time(12 credits)
- 62.8% of graduate students are part time (6 credits)
- 62.1% of all students are female
- 20.2% of all students are minorities and 3.1% are two or more races
- 31% of all undergraduates are “non-traditional” (≥ 25)
- 57.6% of the undergraduates are upper classmen and account for 57% of fall 2018 undergraduate credits
- In 2017-18, there were 176,654 credits taken by students
- 80.21% of our Alumni live in Michigan
- Since 1956, UM-Flint has conferred 39,092 undergraduate and 7,861 graduate degrees
- 2017-18 Fiscal Year Equated Students (FYES) was 6,353

Transfers

- 10.7% of the undergraduates (647) are New Transfer students
- Top 6 feeders: Mott 30.9%, Lansing Community College 4.8%, Oakland Community College 4.6%, St. Clair Co. Community College 4.5%, Delta 4.5%, and Baker College 3.7%.

Freshman Class

- 11% (669) of the undergraduates are new freshman
- 95.81% of the new freshmen are full time
- 55.9% of the new freshmen are female
- 22.6% of the new freshmen are from minority groups and 4.3% are two or more races
- 1.5% are International students
- Average High School GPA was 3.42
- Average SAT Score:1090
- Top Feeder High Schools: Grand Blanc 11.3%, Davison 4.5%, Flushing Senior High 4.5%, Kearsley 3.5%, Swartz Creek 3.2%, Fenton 3.2%, Carman-Ainsworth 2.6%, Goodrich 2.6%, Powers 2.3%

Retention & Graduation

- First Year Retention Rate for Full Time First Time Freshman was 72.26% for the 2017 cohort
- Four Year Graduation rate was 14.48% for 2012 cohort
- Six Year Graduation rate was 46.17% for 2012 cohort
- Eight Year Graduation rate was 44.26% for 2009 cohort

Undergraduate Majors

There are 138 majors/concentrations/specializations that apply to 12 Bach-Deg

- 18.30% undergraduates are Nursing or pre-nursing majors
- 20.08% STEM (Science, Engineering, Technology and Math)
- 14.43% of undergraduates are Business majors
- 2.41% are Education Related majors of which 7.48% are pursuing teaching in Science & Math
- 4.53% of undergraduates are non-teaching Biology or Biochemistry majors
- 4.44% of undergraduates are Computer Science or Information Systems majors
- 30.15% of undergraduates have not declared a major (includes

Undergraduate Degrees

- In 2017-18, UM-Flint conferred 1178 undergraduate degrees.
- 16.72% of all UG degrees issued in Business
- 21.05% of all UG degrees issued in Nursing
- 16.38% of all UG degrees issued in STEM programs
- 5.01% of all UG degrees issued in Education

Graduate Majors

44 majors/concentrations/specializations, 1 Post Bach-Cert, 2 Post Master-Deg, 5 Post Master-Cert, 9 Prof-Doc, 2 Acad-Doc, and 3 Post Doc-Cert

- 14.77% of graduate students are in Education
- 15.96% of graduate students are in Physical Therapy
- 15.40% of graduate students are in Business
- 23.97% of graduate students are in Nursing
- 7.53% of graduate students are in Public Administration

Graduate Degrees

- In 2017-18 UM-F conferred 506 graduate degrees
- 18.2% issued in Education
- 15.6% issued in Business
- 6.7% issued in Public Administration
- 15.2% issued were in Physical Therapy
