## Quick Facts – Fall 2020

### General Student Body

- 6,829 Total Students
- 5,424 Undergraduate students
- 1,405 Graduate students
- 94.6% of all students are Michigan Residents
- 50.4% live in Genesee County (3923 students)
- 154 (2.26%) International students (NRA)
- Greatest number of International students come from; Saudi Arabia (44; 28.6%), India (33; 21.4%), and China (15; 9.7%)
- 60.8% of undergraduates are full time(12 credits)
- 58% of graduate students are part time (6 credits)
- 64.4% of all students are female
- 21.5% of all students are URM
- 28.6% of all undergraduates are “non-traditional” ( $\geq 25$ )
- 60.3% of the undergraduates are upper classmen and account for 61.5% of fall 2020 undergraduate credits
- In 2018-19, there were 166,708 credits taken by students
- 80% of our Alumni live in Michigan
- Since 1956, UM-Flint has conferred 39,064 undergraduate and 8,770 graduate degrees
- 2019-20 Fiscal Year Equated Students (FYES) was 6,085

### Transfers

- 9.2% of the undergraduates (500) are Transfer students
- Top 6 feeders: Mott 25.8%, LCC 8.8%, Baker 4.6%, OCC 4.2%, MSU 3.6%, and CMU 3%

### Freshman Class

- 10.3% (559) of the undergraduates are new freshman
- 93% of the new freshmen are full time
- 59% of the new freshmen are female
- 22.7% of the new freshmen are URM
- .4% are International students
- Average High School GPA was 3.49
- Average SAT Composite Score was 1086
- Top Feeder HS : Grand Blanc 11.3%, Carman-Ainsworth 6.1%, Davison 4.8%, Flushing 3.6%, Swartz Creek 3.2%, Powers Catholic 2.9%, Hartland 2.7%, Lapeer HS 2.7%, Lake Fenton 2.5%, Elizabeth Ann Johnson memorial 2.5%

### Retention & Graduation

- First Year Retention Rate for Full Time First Time Freshman was 72.4% for the 2019 cohort
- Four Year Graduation rate was 13.78% for 2014 cohort
- Six Year Graduation rate was 38.49% for 2014 cohort
- Eight Year Graduation rate was 50.94% for 2012 cohort

### Undergraduate Majors

There are over 100 possible majors/concentrations/specializations that apply to 12 Bachelor Degrees.

- 17.6% undergraduates are Nursing or pre-nursing majors
- 20.2% STEM (Science, Engineering, Technology and Math)
- 13% of undergraduates are Business majors
- 3.4% are Education Related Majors
- 8.1% of undergraduates are non-teaching Biology or Biochemistry majors
- 5.0% of undergraduates are Computer Science or Information Systems majors
- 29.1% of undergraduates have not declared a major

### Undergraduate Degrees

- In 2019-20 UM-Flint conferred 1,066 undergraduate degrees.
- 23.9% of all UG degrees issued in Nursing
- 21.5% of all UG degrees issued in Business
- 16.2% of all UG degrees issued in STEM programs
- 2.7% of all UG degrees issued in Elementary Education and Teaching

### Graduate Majors

Of the possible majors/concentrations/specialization combination programs offered present:

41 different Master's Degree Programs, 5 Post Bachelor's Certificate, 1 Post Master's Degree, 8 Post Master's Certificate, 17 Professional Doctoral, 2 Ph.D's

- 10.7% of graduate students are in Education
- 14.7% of graduate students are in Physical Therapy
- 20.2% of graduate students are in Business
- 25.4% of graduate students are in Nursing
- 4.3% of graduate students are in Public Administration

### Graduate Degrees

- In 2019-20 UM-Flint conferred 523 graduate degrees
- 12.4% issued in Education
- 16.4% issued in Business
- 9.0% issued in Public Administration
- 14.0% issued were in Physical Therapy

### Faculty & Staff

- Total Regular is 1,005 = 707 FT & 298 PT
- Total Staff is 462 = 434 FT & 28 PT
- Total Grad Assistant = 41 ( Research)
- Total Faculty is 502 = 273 FT & 229 PT
- 49% of Full-Time Faculty - Tenured
- 17% Full Time-Faculty - Tenure Track
- 34% Full Time-Faculty - Not on Tenure system
- 19% Full Time-Faculty - minority groups
- 19% Full Time-Staff - minority groups
