General Student Body

- 8,470 Total Students
- 6,868 Undergraduate students
- 1,602 Graduate students
- 88.5% of all students are Michigan Residents
- 56.9% live in Genesee County (4820 students)
- 720 (8.5%) International students (NRA); up 8.59% from 2014
- Greatest number of International students come from; India (261; 36.25%), Saudi Arabia (251; 34.86%), and China (62; 8.61%)
- 61.73% of undergraduates are full time(12 credits)
- 60.48% of graduate students are part time (6 credits)
- 60.11% of all students are female
- 19.42% of all students are minorities and 2.85% are two or more races
- 35.85% of all undergraduates are “non-traditional” (>25)
- 61.12% of the undergraduates are upper classmen and account for 60.5% of fall 2015 undergraduate credits
- In 2014-15, there were 195,108 credits taken by students
- 77.38% of our Alumni live in Michigan
- Since 1956, UM-Flint has conferred 35,465 undergraduate and 6,303 graduate degrees
- 2014-15 Fiscal Year Equated Students (FYES) was 7,013
- Faculty to Student FTE Ratio 1 to 15
- Staff to Student FTE Ratio 1 to 12

Transfers

- 10.94% of the undergraduates (752) are New Transfer students
- Top feeders: Mott 33.51%, Lansing community college 5.72%, Baker 5.45%, St. Clair Co. Community College:5.32%

Freshman Class

- 9.34% (642) of the undergraduates are new freshman
- 91.58% of the new freshmen are full time
- 60.43% of the new freshmen are women
- 32.24% of the new freshmen are from minority groups and 4.67% are two or more races
- 5.60% are International students
- Average High School GPA was 3.26
- Average ACT Composite Score was 20.90
- Top feeders: Grand Blanc HS 9.50%, Power Catholic High School: 4.52% Carman-Ainsworth High School: 4.05%, Out of State High School: 4.05%, Flushing Senior High School: 3.74%, Davison High School: 3.43%.

Retention & Graduation

- First Year Retention Rate for Full Time First Time Freshman was 72.10% for the 2014 cohort; up .37% from the fall 2013 cohort retention rate
- Four Year Graduation rate was 10.78% for 2009 cohort
- Six Year Graduation rate was 38.01% for 2009 cohort
- Eight Year Graduation rate was 42.00% for 2006 cohort

Undergraduate Majors

There are over 100 possible majors/concentrations/specializations that apply to 13 Bachelor Degrees.

- 19.1% undergraduates are Nursing or pre-nursing majors
- 18.1% STEM (Science, Engineering, Technology and Math)
- 14.8% of undergraduates are Business majors
- 2.5% are Education Related majors of which 10.3% are pursuing teaching in Science & Math
- 3.6% of undergraduates are non-teaching Biology or Biochemistry majors
- 4.5% of undergraduates are Computer Science or Information Systems majors
- 12.5% of undergraduates have not declared a major

Undergraduate Degrees

- In 2014-15 UM-Flint conferred 1,223 undergraduate degrees.
- 14.71% of all UG degrees issued in Business
- 24.52% of all UG degrees issued in Nursing
- 9.40% of all UG degrees issued in STEM programs
- 7.35% of all UG degrees issued in Elementary or Secondary Education

Graduate Majors

21 different Masters Degrees, 1 Post Bachelor's Certificate, 1 Post Master's Degree, 5 Prof Doctoral, 1 Ph.D, and 9 Post Graduate Certificates

- 15.1% of graduate students are in Education
- 14.4% of graduate students are in Physical Therapy
- 12.2% of graduate students are in Business
- 13.2% of graduate students are in Nursing
- 7.3% of graduate students are in Public Administration

Graduate Degrees

- In 2014-15 UM-F conferred 435 graduate degrees
- 16.1% issued in Education
- 21.6% issued in Business
- 10.1% issued in Public Administration
- 18.4% issued were in Physical Therapy

Faculty & Staff

- Total regular is 1,212 = 819 FT & 393 PT
- Total Staff is 628 = 501 FT & 38 PT & 89 GSRA
- Total Faculty is 584 = 318 FT & 266 PT
- 69.8% of Full-Time Faculty Doctoral or Terminal degree
- 35.2% of Full-Time Faculty - Tenured
- 26.1% Full Time-Faculty - Tenure Track
- 38.7% Full Time-Faculty - Not on Tenure system
- 22.6% Full Time-Faculty - minority groups
- 17.8% Full Time-Staff - minority groups
