### Transition to Your BBA at the University of Michigan-Flint School of Management

The School of Management at the University of Michigan-Flint (UM-Flint) and Wayne County Community College District (WCCCD) have an articulation agreement to provide an easy transition for WCCCD students transferring to UM-Flint to pursue their Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) degree.

The School of Management at UM-Flint offers:

- Accreditation by AACSB-International, the premier accreditation association for business schools.
- Day, evening, and online courses with small class sizes.
- Highly accomplished professors that actively engage in teaching and research.
- The ability to complete your BBA with a general business concentration entirely online (assumes completion of general education and pre-business requirements).
- A business internship program.
- Study abroad opportunities.
- Business student organizations.

The UM-Flint BBA program is designed to meet the needs of traditional students, returning students, and students already established in their professional careers. This guide illustrates course equivalencies and maps a curriculum plan that allows WCCCD students to transfer with ease.

### **Bachelor of Business Administration Requirements**

- Completion of specific course requirements in general education, English, mathematics, economics, and business administration, totaling 120 or more credits (including at least 60 credits of non-business courses).
- Completion of at least 48 credit hours in business administration, including at least 36 credits in upper-division courses and at least 30 credits completed at UM-Flint.
- Completion of the two-course, non-business focus elective.
- Achievement of minimum grade point averages of 2.0 in the overall college work, in courses taken in the School
  of Management, and in the concentration area.
- Completion of at least 45 credits while enrolled at UM-Flint (in residence), including the last 30 credits (senior year enrollment).

#### **Transfer Guidelines**

- Grade of "C" or better is required for courses to transfer.
- A minimum overall GPA of 2.0 is required to be considered for admission to the University.
