

## HAIL Scholarship Program

### FAQ

- What is the HAIL Scholarship Program?
  - The HAIL (High Achieving Involved Leader) Scholarship is an initiative designed to increase the enrollment at the University of Michigan- Ann Arbor with high-achieving students from across the state of Michigan, who have demonstrated a financial need. The program provides tuition assistance to students from more than 250 public high schools throughout the state.
- Who is eligible to apply as a HAIL student?
  - Students who apply to the University of Michigan- Ann Arbor before application deadlines and meet the scholarship criteria.
- Who makes the admissions decision to the HAIL Scholarship Program?
  - UM – Ann Arbor’s Office of Undergraduate Admissions makes the final decision regarding HAIL Program admission.
- How can students use their HAIL Scholarship at UM-Dearborn or UM-Flint?
  - Select students who are not admitted to UM-Ann Arbor but show promise in their academic achievement, have the option to attend UM- Dearborn or UM-Flint, utilizing the scholarship. Students may continue their study at either Dearborn or Flint, or they may elect to apply to transfer Ann Arbor after successfully completing their freshman year.
- What is the UM – Ann Arbor transfer criteria?
  - Those students who have successfully completed their freshman year may elect to transfer to UM- Ann Arbor if they meet the following requirements:
    - Transfer into a program of study within the College of Literature, Science, and Arts at UM- Ann Arbor.
    - The College of Engineering as part of the Flint 2+2 program.
    - The College of Engineering as part of the Dearborn Preferred Transfer Agreement program.
    - Complete the first year fall/winter semester with 24+ transferable college credits and 3.2+ GPA for each of the semesters with no grade below a C.
- How are students notified of the transfer process?
  - UM- Ann Arbor will notify HAIL recipients at UM-Dearborn and UM-Flint campus’ when transfer applications are available.
- If I am a HAIL Scholarship recipient and I want to use my scholarship at UM-Dearborn or UM-Flint, is that possible?
  - For those students who are admitted to UM-Ann Arbor as a HAIL recipient and want to attend UM-Dearborn or UM-Flint, special consideration will be given by Ann Arbor.
