4. Essay describing your need for scholarship assistance.

**NOTE:** If a recipient fails to enroll, cancels, or withdraws for any term covered by the scholarship award, the amount of the award for that term and any succeeding terms will be forfeited and returned to the scholarship account. Any request for an exception to this policy must be submitted in writing to the Office of Financial Aid prior to, or at the time of, cancellation or withdrawal. The University of Michigan-Flint Scholarships Committee must approve the requests. If an award is forfeited, students will be responsible for any resulting tuition charges or fees.
