SUBJECT: Prohibition Regarding Possession of Firearms, Dangerous Weapons, or
Dangerous Knives on Our Campus or at Events

Ensuring the safety and well-being of our students, faculty, staff, and visitors on the University of Michigan-Flint campus is of the utmost concern and importance. The presence of firearms, dangerous weapons, or dangerous knives on our campus or at any UM-Flint sponsored event or activity can create disruption to ensuring a supportive, productive and positive educational environment for our students, faculty, staff, and visitors. The activities of students, faculty, staff, and visitors can be and have been disrupted when an individual has or is suspected of having a firearm, dangerous weapon or dangerous knife. As a result, I have determined that the UM-Flint campus, including any leased space as may be permitted by state law, will not allow firearms, dangerous weapons or dangerous knives on the UM-Flint campus property or at any UM-Flint sponsored events or activities, except as may be required for law enforcement or for specified purposes consistent with the conditions described in the Regents' Ordinance.

I therefore direct you to establish and maintain procedures, as set forth above, to ensure the continued safety of our students, faculty, staff, and visitors on campus and at all UM-Flint sponsored events and activities as well as the proper handling of emergency situations. The procedures should provide that appropriate security, safety, and health measures are in place to protect our students, faculty, staff, and visitors as well as University property from injury or damage. These procedures and requirements are to be posted on the UM-Flint web site.
